

Notice of Primary Election

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 13th day of May, 2014 at the polling places in the election precincts of Clay County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices. Some races will not appear on the Primary Election as the number of candidates filing does not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and advance to the November 4th, 2014 General Election. Voters living in school districts that cross county lines will be voting on candidates and special issues in their respective districts. The number of delegates to the Republican party and Democrat party county conventions are the same in number or less than the number of candidates to be elected, therefore, the names shall not appear on the primary election ballot and those so filed shall receive a certificate of election. Proposed Amendments to the Constitution and Initiatives or Referendums will be published by the Secretary of State once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.
