ISSUE # 1**

Shall the City of Sutton establish an Economic Development Program as described here by appropriating annually approximately \$75,000.00 for fifteen (15) years?

Terms and Conditions of the Program.

A. The goals of the program are to promote existing industries and the retention of jobs, and to recruit new industries and jobs to the community.

The goals are further directed at maintaining a good quality of life for our citizens and a strong workforce, developing community resources; attracting new capital investment; broadening the community's tax base; and ensuring economic stability and viability for the City of Sutton and surrounding areas.

B. Funds for the program may be used for purchasing real estate or options for real estate, developing small businesses and expansions thereof, recruiting quality businesses into the area, investing equity in qualifying businesses, creating a revolving loan fund, and conducting other economic development activities allowable under Nebraska Law determined to be beneficial to the City of Sutton and surrounding areas.

C. The program shall commence April 1, 2021 and end April 1, 2036, a fifteen (15) year period.

D. Collection of funds shall begin on April 1, 2021 and end April 1, 2036.

E. The source from which funds are to be collected shall be from a one-half percent (1/2 %) City Local Option Sales Tax or the issuance of bonds to be retired by said sales tax.

F. The total amount to be collected from the local sources of revenue for the Economic Development Program will be approximately \$75,000.00 per year over a fifteen (15) year period for an approximate total of \$1,125,000.00.

ISSUE # 2

Shall the governing body of Sutton, Nebraska impose a one-half percent (1/2 %) sales and use tax upon the same transactions within the City of Sutton, Nebraska on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax with the proceeds of such tax being allocated to fund the Sutton Community Economic Development Program beginning April 1, 2021 and ending April 1, 2036?

And shall the City of Sutton, Nebraska increase its budgeted restricted funds for fiscal year 2020-2021 by \$75,000.00 over the current year's restricted funds?
