Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2020 **BY MAIL** for ALL election precincts of Clay County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The ballots must be returned to the Clay County Clerk's office by 8:00 p.m. on election day. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices. Some races will not appear on the Primary Election as the number of candidates filing does not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and advance to the November 3rd, 2020 General Election. Proposed Amendments to the Constitution and Initiatives or Referendums will be published by the Secretary of State. Terms are for Four years unless otherwise noted.
