Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot.</li> <li>4. TO VOTE, you must darken the oval (●) completely.</li> <li>5. To vote for a WRITE-IN candidate, write in the name on the line provided AND darken the oval completely.</li> </ol> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. Do NOT cross out or erase. If you make a mistake, contact the County Clerk's office at (402-762-3463) for instructions.</li> <li>7. Place voted ballot into the brown return envelope and complete, SIGN and seal the envelope.</li> <li>8. Any person physically unable to sign the envelope must make his/her "mark" and must have an individual witness. Failure to complete and sign the Return Identification Envelope will cause the ballot to be rejected.</li> <li>9. Return Ballot by:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a.
