## COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDINGS

The Clay County Board of Supervisors acting as the Board of Equalization met January 26, 2021 as per public notice given in the Clay County News on January 20, 2021 a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. Chairman Johnson presided with roll call showing the following present: Bitterman, Pavelka, Schmidt, Shaw, Fintel and Johnson; Absent: Samuelson.
