COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDINGS

Courthouse Clay Center, Nebraska, June 29, 2021 at 11:55 A.M. (upon adjournment of the Board of Supervisors meeting)

The Clay County Board of Supervisors acting as the Board of Equalization met June 29, 2021 as per public notice given in the Clay County News on June 23, 2021 a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. Chairman Johnson presided with roll call showing the following present: Bitterman, Samuelson, Pavelka, Schmidt, Fintel, Shaw and Johnson. Minutes of the meeting held June 22, 2021 were mailed to the board members. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Motion by Schmidt and seconded by Pavelka to approve the minutes of the meeting held June 22, 2021 as mailed. On roll call, yea: Samuelson, Pavelka, Schmidt, Fintel, Shaw, Bitterman and Johnson. Motion carried.
