

COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDINGS

The Clay County Board of Supervisors acting as the Board of Equalization met October 24, 2023 as per public notice given in the Clay County News on October 18, 2023 a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. Chairman L. Wayne Johnson presided with roll call showing the following present: Samuelson, Becker, Pavelka, Fintel, Shaw and Johnson; Absent: Bitterman. Minutes of the meeting October 17, 2023 were mailed to the board members. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.
