


CLAY COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY AND EASEMENT POLICY

1. Any underground utility work done within the limits of Clay County Right-of-Way must be bored. No open trench excavation will be allowed for any underground electric, water, gas, etc. utilities.
2. Any work performed on county right-of-way must be approved by the Clay County Board of Supervisors before any work is performed.
3. All disturbed county right-of-way must be restored to the previous condition. Any cost incurred, due to repair of the right-of-way by Clay County, will be at the expense of the landowner and or the parties responsible for the work performed.
4. Any underground utility work performed in the county right-of-way must be clearly marked by a sign provided by the county at the time of easement approval.
5. Any underground utility work, such as phone and natural gas service lines installed within the right-of-way may be trenched where boring is not practical due to the usual length of the utility line. This will be approved by the Board of Supervisors before work is performed.
6. Nothing contained herein shall prevent Clay County from prosecuting any violator of this policy for damages, cost of repair, or any negligence due to the non compliance of the above said policy.
